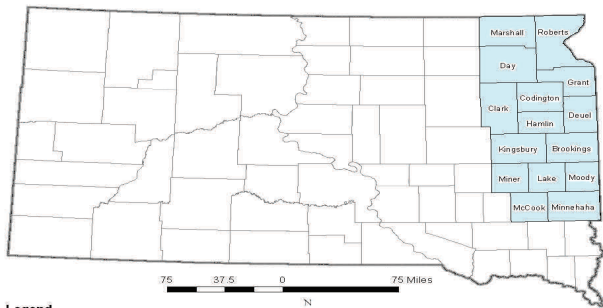




Prairie Coteau Water Development Grant

The main priorities of the Districts have been water quality, soil erosion, and grassland management. The improvement of natural resource conditions will benefit the region as a whole by improving range conditions, providing better water quality, and will provide the reduction of soil loss by wind and water.



Reliable water sources for livestock and technical assistance for rotational grazing management will lead to a healthier grassland ecosystem. In addition to higher quality grasslands for livestock and upland nesting birds, the project will ultimately provide improved water quality and reduced amounts of downstream erosion.



The various types of water sources will be utilized and strategically located to maximize benefits to grassland management which will prove beneficial for wildlife production, erosion reduction, and improved water quality. All associated rangeland surrounding the water developments will be assisted in developing a grazing management plan and given grazing informational products including "Greener Pastures".
