

NATIVE PERENNIALS



Aster, New England (*Aster novae-angliae*) Stout erect perennial with several branches growing 20” to 40” from a single base. Several flowers form on the terminal end of the stems. Flowers are large blue-violet to reddish purple with yellow centers. Is found on wet prairie meadows, stream banks and boggy areas.
